

AFLGA Member Meeting Minutes

June 13, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Margi Honea, President and discussions were held as follows:

➤ Prize Awards

Discussion included how many gross and net awards to be given per flight. It was decided that if the game lends itself, a gross prize and one net will be awarded to the first flight only and that two net prizes for all other flights would be awarded this season. It will be the tournament chairman's decision each week.

➤ Club Championship

The members voted to have the Club Championship on two consecutive days, despite there being suggestions to play over two consecutive weeks. The Club Championship will be on August 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> with the luncheon being on August 10<sup>th</sup>.

➤ The Eclectic Tournament

The Eclectic is a game played over two consecutive weeks where the player records the first week then tries to improve each hole the second week. The best hole for either week is recorded for the final score. Net score will be calculated as well based on player handicap. The entry fee is 10.00 for the tournament and players have the option of adding another 5.00 per week as a side bet for each individual day of play. A player wanting to play both days with side bets would pay 20.00 total. A player may also play one or two days of the tournament with no side bet or may want to play one or two days with only a side bet on one of the two days. A 5.00 side bet per day of play for best gross and best net per flight in addition to money set aside for the two day event total is planned.

➤ Tuesday Play Days

The Board suggested players start paying 3.00 each Tuesday to play in the game. This will be added to the money coming out of the general fund for prizes. This was proposed to increase the payouts so they be equitable for those playing each week. Because some members don't play as often, the Board thought this was a good alternative to raising the membership fee at the beginning of the season. Hopefully we can encourage more ladies to join the club if the membership fee is reasonable. We will include closest to the pin prizes each week as is appropriate for the game and continue side bets for chip-ins and low putts. This is a voluntary cash prize and all other prize money will be in gift certificates for the pro shop.

➤ Finally, the members voted the from next week on, it is acceptable for a player to pick up at their ESC for games where not all holes count. This is in an effort to speed play.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
