- We had a discussion to propose a cap on hole-in-one money. Should we cap the collection of money at \$500 or keep it at \$1000?
  - Possible idea for future discussion.
- After reviewing the treasury budget, there will be payouts for the first 3 weeks of September play dates (Sept 1, 8 & 15, 2020), but will need to review how much will actually be paid.
  - Working with Greg W. (Pro shop) to determine the result for the past 3 weeks of September play (see dates above), and will determine what payouts should be.
  - Results of those play dates are posted on the Web site and printed out in the meeting minutes book.
- Chair positions:
  - Diana Winklemann will be play date chair for Tuesday ladies play and special/couples tournaments (pairings, tee times, etc.)
    - We will check with Susan Alley to see if she will assist Diana as backup with the responsibility.
  - Theresa Renegar, as Treasurer, will also assume the duty of year-end awards chair.
  - Mandy Holleman, as Vice President, will remain Rules Chair
  - Jamie Elliott - Handicap for 2021.
  - Linda Bealessio - Webmaster 2021
- Questions: Should we pay as we go? Should we have 2 play days, Monday and/or Tuesday?
  - Possibly, lower the club dues but player must sign-up and pay per play date.
  - Dues suggestion:
    - \$25 for GHIN
    - \$25 for General Fund for League
  - The player(s) will pay a separate entry of \$10 for play day - be it Monday or Tuesday but not both.
  - Payouts will be a percentage of places/flights/players.

- Payout sheet will be reevaluated and modified for 2021 by Theresa & Sherrie. A new one will be printed out once adjusted.
- Flights:
  - 18 hole will have 2 flights
    - 1st and 2nd place payout
  - 9 hole will have 1 flight
    - 1st and 2nd place payout
- The 'Birdie Tree' will be reevaluated and examples to be added - under discussion.
